2. Harmonics on 1st notes, no vibrato. **Air:** speed, support, angle and volume
3. Vowels - Ah to Oh to OPEN
4. Vibrato - Expressive and listening for Connection and Expression.
5. Sing & Play
6. Flutter Tongue
7. Variety of Breathing Ideas: Ho, How, Hawaii, double check, Finger Breaths...
8. Body: Whole body active, Surfer/Skateboard Squat, Left Leg Lift, Against the Wall, Jump up...
9. Isolate the Top Register Notes. Chunking Practice.
